

James Banner - CV of 'failures'

During a lecture I delivered to graduating students at Leeds College of Music in early 2019 we discussed the idea of finding and creating opportunities as a professional musician, amongst many other things. The overarching theme was that work opportunities (commissions, finding gigs, recording opportunities, teaching positions etc.) are in general very hard to come by, and succeeding in those areas, whilst of course necessary for most freelance musicians, is difficult and can sometimes seem insurmountable as a student entering the professional world - something I also felt myself as an undergraduate. Even more important to realise and fight against are the systemic barriers such as sexism, ageism, ableism, classism and racism facing those coming from marginalised groups which make this process even more difficult.

To illustrate the point in numbers from my own experience only, I decided to tally up how many opportunities I had applied for in the previous two years and how many of those had succeeded, the result being 6 out of around 30-35 at the time (beginning of 2019, some were pending) - around 20%. I had personally never considered this 'success' rate to be low since the 'failures' I had incurred during the process (learning how to write applications, updating my CV, making new contacts etc.) had been so valuable to me as a tool for my own development, even though 20% in most other contexts would be considered a fail.

Throughout the Coronavirus pandemic 2020-21 I placed much less importance on applying for opportunities that I had previously I applied for. I realised that these types of programmes were not necessarily the only route, that a better way forward for me personally was to use the time, equipment and privilege I have to widen my network, actively engage with more composers and performers, essentially to 'DIY' some of these opportunities myself rather than take up space in applications. I realised my own work does not fit and will never fit into certain scenes that many of these opportunities belong, and that it was not healthy or honest to try to adjust my work accordingly. As a start, I began to organise free double bass workshops for composers to learn more about writing for the instrument and started to record new/unperformed pieces for their portfolios. This was just the beginning of a new approach which I have personally found more inspiring and rewarding, and which has lead to increased creative contact and development with others on my own terms, rather than 'failing' to fit into the boxes of others.

This 'CV' may hopefully show someone that the 'failures' are inevitable, normal and worthwhile, and to go some way in normalising how widespread rejection is generally in the arts. Not that normalising this makes it ok, but engaging in conversation about this publicly, especially in the perceived perfect world of social media, may go some way in recognising mental health and artistic/financial survival in the freelance art world.

Credit goes to Lecturer Melanie Stefan for this idea, and to Composer Jenni Pinnock for passing it on to me. I decided to do this myself because of an interest in Carol Dweck's Growth Mindset (a concept introduced to me by musician Megan Jowett), and my recent introduction to an academic world where I am lucky to be able to discover new viewpoints on successes and failures from my own students.

n.b. for clarity, I don't include any 'non-failures' except where they are directly related to a 'failure'. In terms of performances, this list also only includes applications made for festivals, not venues, since there are too many 'failures' to list in this area (approx. contact of 100+ venues per year).
